Let nothing disturb you. God never changes.

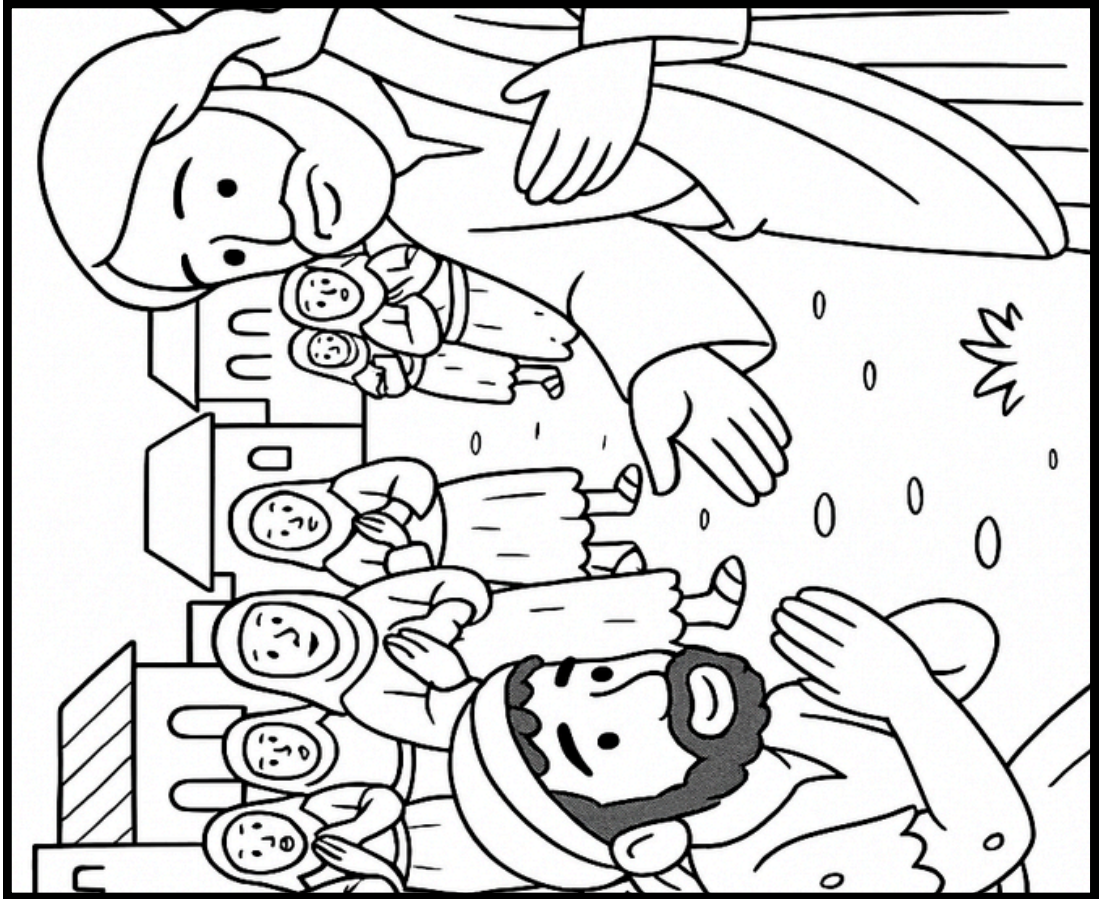
