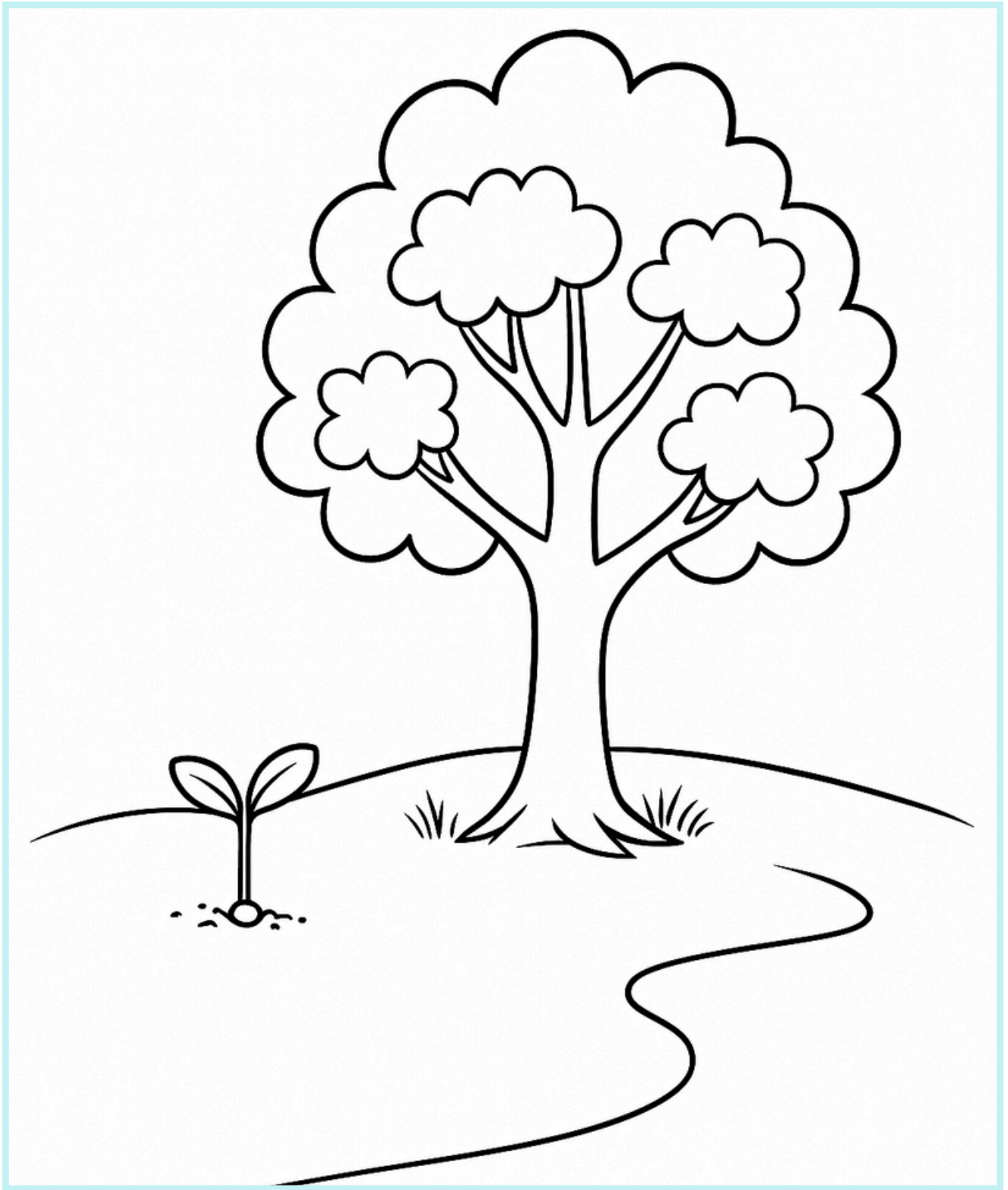


Jesus said that even a tiny bit of faith can do amazing things. He wants us to believe in Him and do our duties with love, just like good helpers who serve without asking for praise.

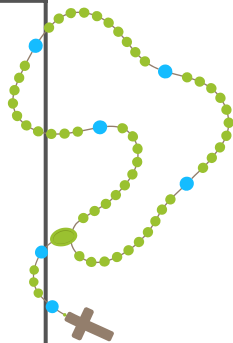

Let's Make Our "Faith Tree" Craft!

What You'll Need:

- The "Faith Tree" printable sheet
- Crayons, markers, or colored pencils
- Scissors (ask an adult to help!)
- Glue or tape

What To Do:

- Color your tree and the tiny seedling with bright, happy colors.
- Carefully cut along the dashed lines around the tree and seedling.
- Glue the seedling near the tree's base on a new piece of paper.
- Stand up your Faith Tree by gently bending the bottom and securing it with tape or glue.
- Add extra details like clouds, sunshine, or little birds around your tree if you want!

Remember: Just like the little mustard seed grows into a big tree, our little faith grows too!

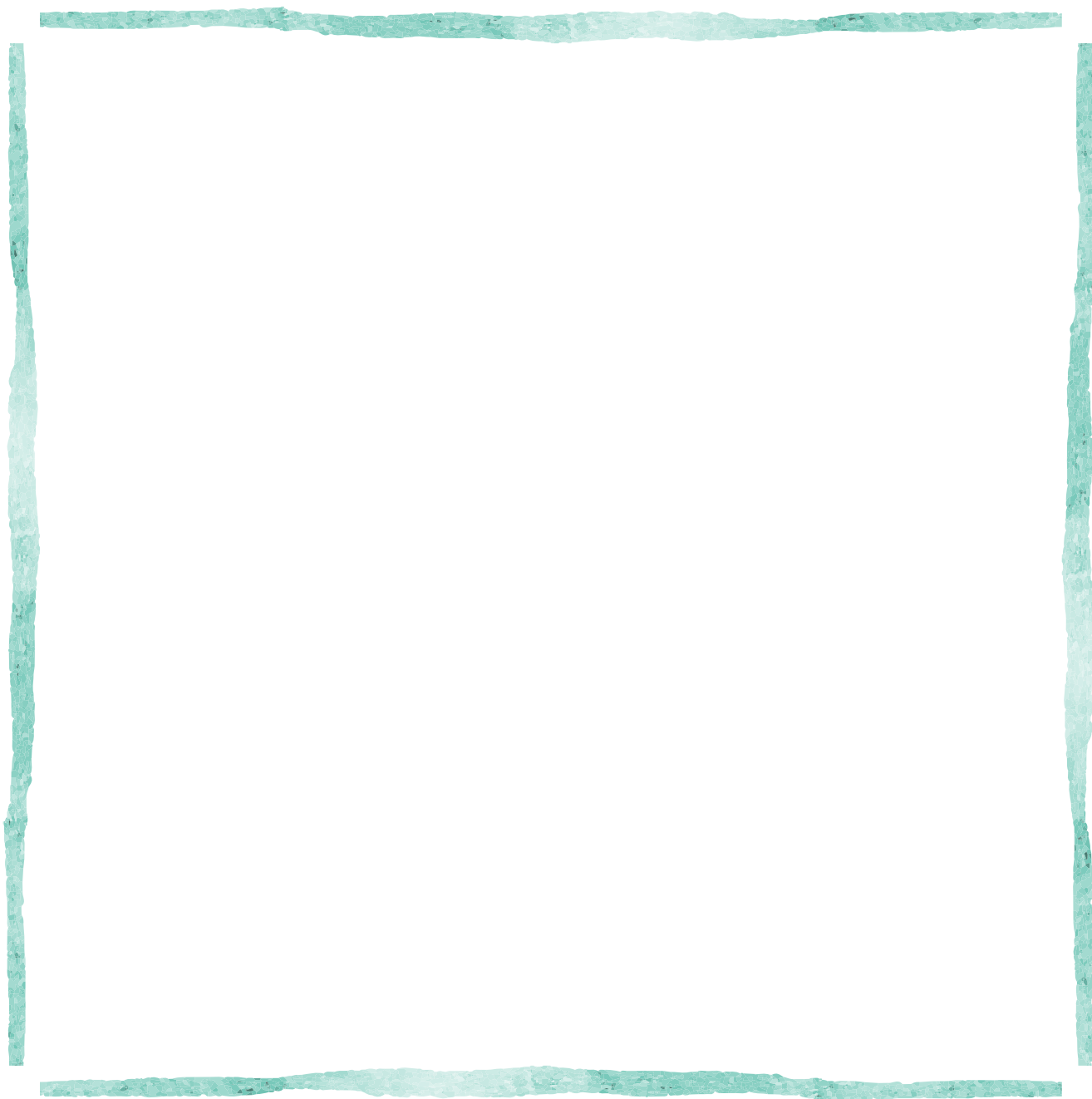


Reflection Page
