St. Luke the Evangelist





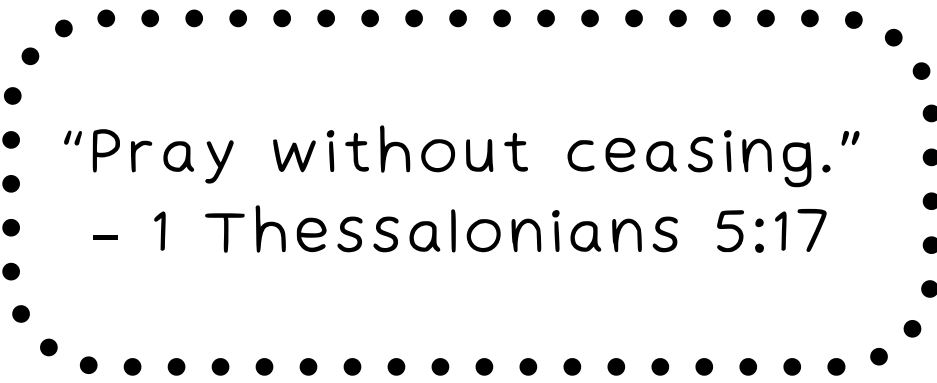

Let's Make Our Prayer Jar!

1. Find a jar (like an old jam jar or a plastic cup).
2. Decorate your jar with stickers, drawings, or a pretty ribbon!
3. Write your name on it so it's special just for you.
4. Cut small pieces of paper for your prayers.
5. Every day, write or draw a prayer on a piece of paper.
 - Ask God to help you be kind, loving, and a good friend.
 - Say a prayer for someone else (like a friend, family, or someone who is sick).
 - Don't pray for things like toys or games—pray for love, kindness, and to help others!
6. Fold your prayer paper and put it in the jar.
7. At the end of the week, read them again and see how God is helping you and others!

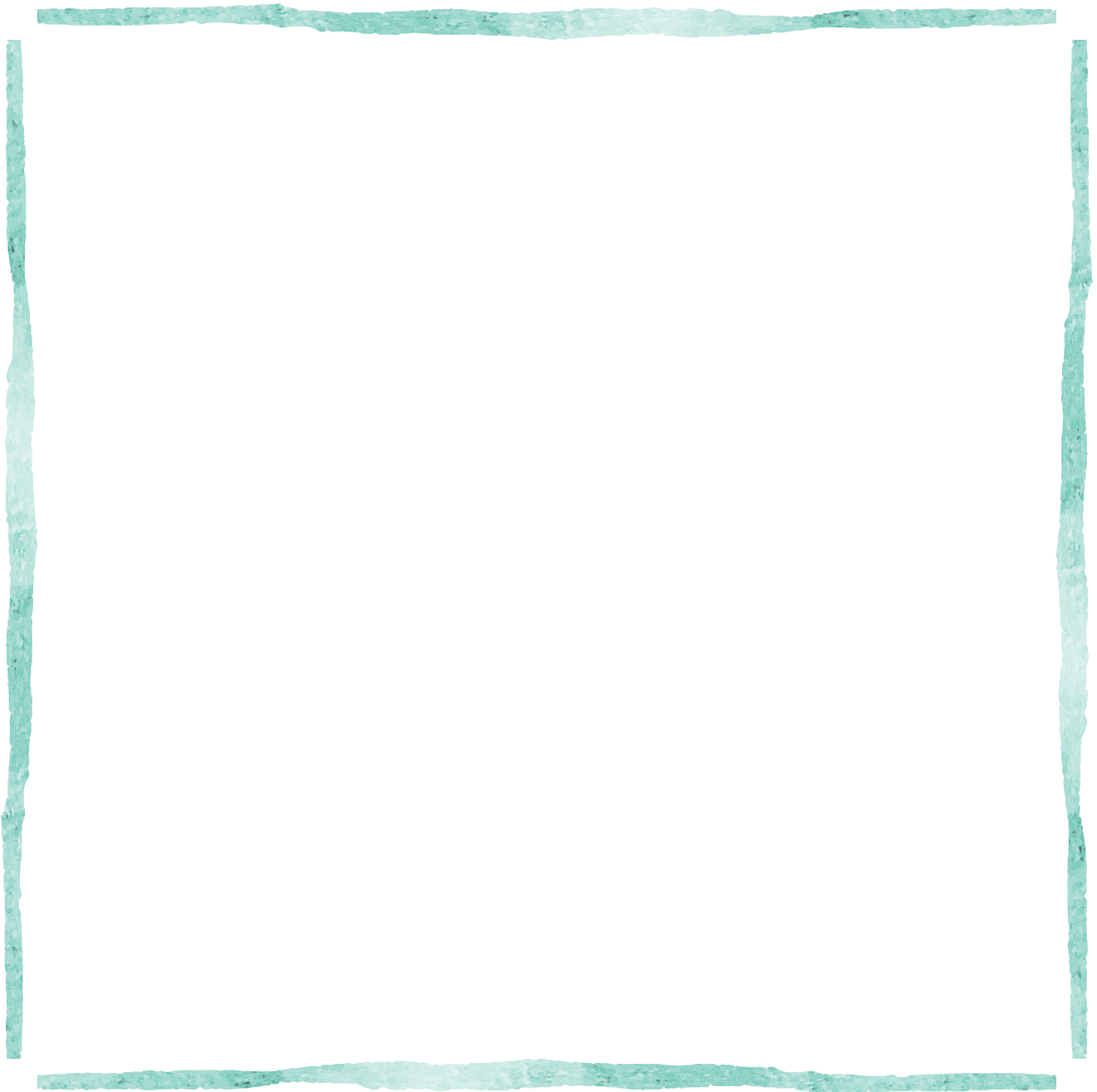
