Compassion is the language of the heart.

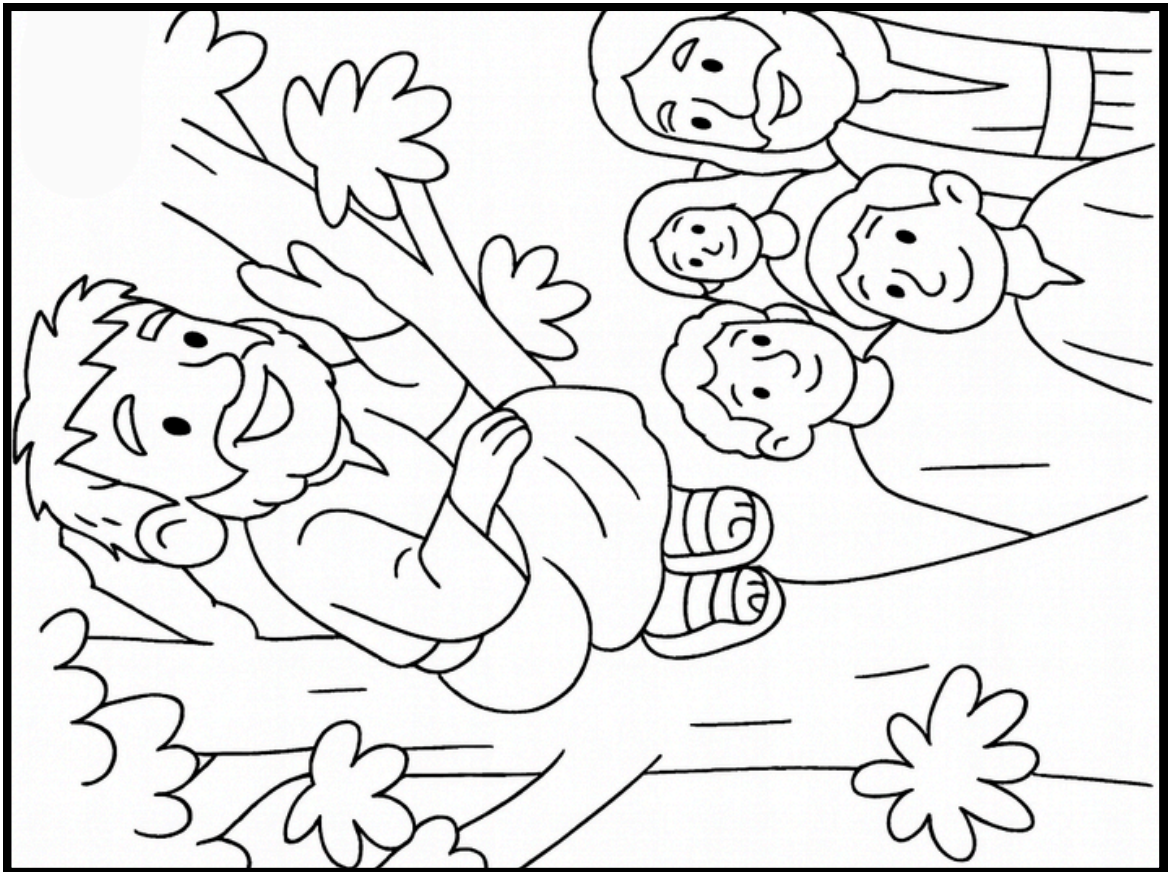

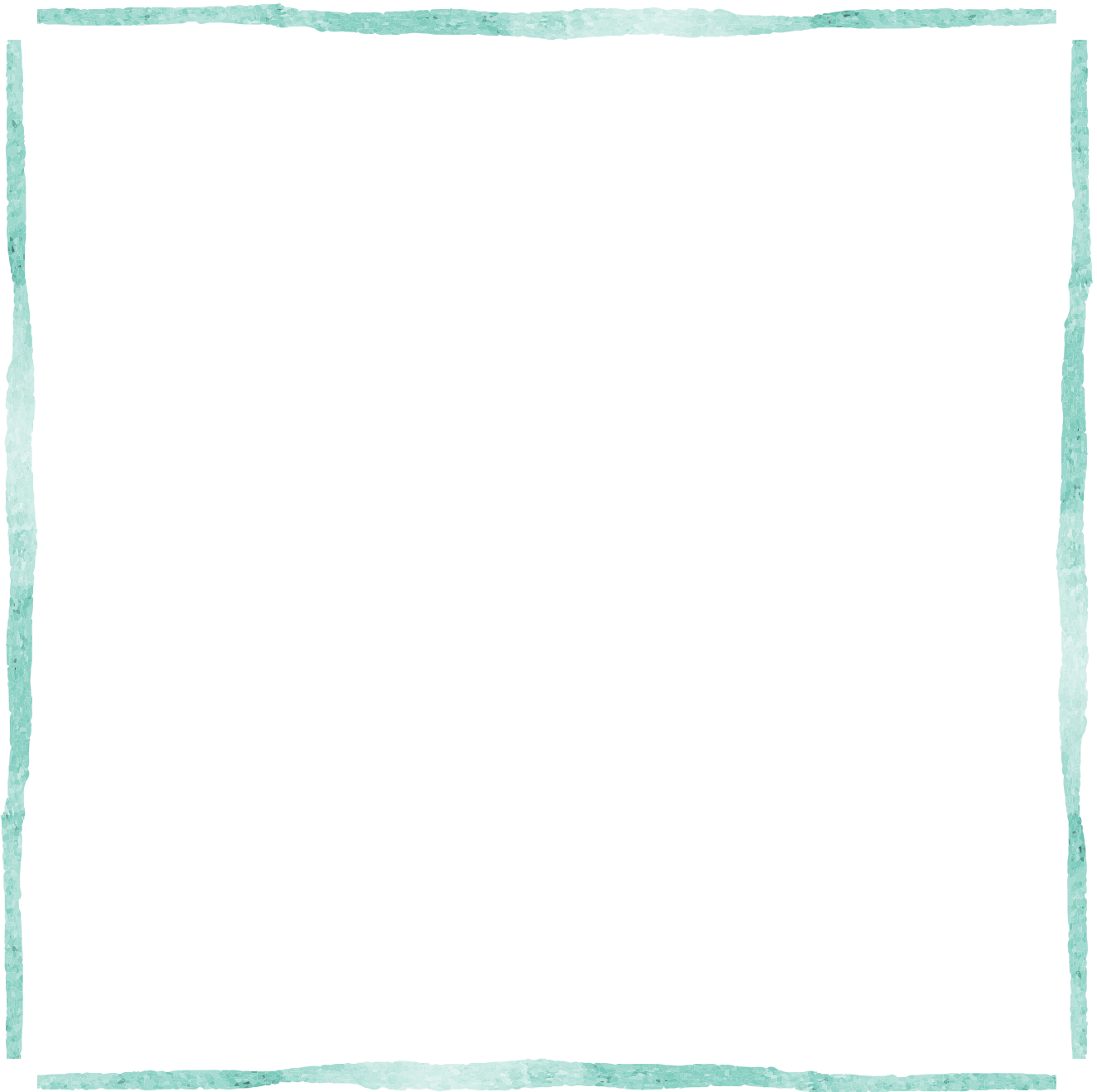


Reflection Page

Welcome Banner

Design your own welcome banner.

1. Who Are You Welcoming?

2. Design Ideas:

- Colors: Pick colors that match your event. Bright colors can be happy and exciting. Softer colors can be calm or serious.
- Fonts: Use letters that are easy to read. You can mix big, bold letters with fancy ones, but make sure people can read the main part easily.
- Pictures: Add fun pictures like balloons for a party or leaves for an outside event.
- Theme: Use ideas that match what your event is about, like snowflakes for a winter party or flags from different countries for a cultural day.

3. Add a Special Touch:

- Make it personal with names or a happy message. This makes people feel special.

4. Size and Place:

- Make sure the banner is big enough to see and put it where everyone can notice it.
